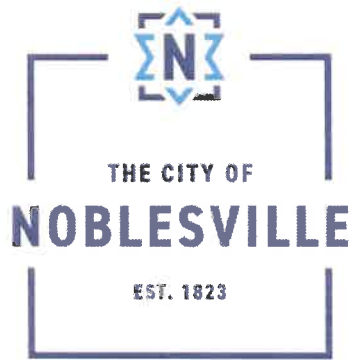

In an effort to provide safe, effective, traffic control and flow for the Homecoming parade on September 15, 2023, the Noblesville P.D. is requesting the following barricades at the streets listed below, preferably no later than 1:00 pm. **Also, we will need no parking signs along Logan Street between 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> street on both sides and on 9<sup>th</sup> street from Logan to Clinton.** Please list the no parking from 3:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. (or when the parade is over) **We also need no parking signs on the South side of Harrison street from 16<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> as this is where the staging area will be for the parade this year.** Please list the no parking from 1:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. (or when the parade is over):

- 2 barricades for Harrison Street and John Street
- 2 barricades for Harrison Street and James Drive
- 2 barricades for Harrison Street and 18<sup>th</sup> Street
- 2 barricades for Monument and 19<sup>th</sup> Street
- 2 barricades for Monument Street and Kings Lane
- 2 barricades for 16<sup>th</sup> Street / Monument Street intersection
- 2 barricades for 16<sup>th</sup> Street / Harrison Street intersection
- 2 barricades for 16<sup>th</sup> Street / Logan Street intersection
- 2 barricades for 16<sup>th</sup> Street/Conner Street Intersection
- 4 barricades for 10<sup>th</sup> Street / Logan Street intersection
- 1 barricade and 3 traffic cones for Conner Street eastbound turn lane @ 10<sup>th</sup> Street
- 2 barricades for 10<sup>th</sup> Street / Clinton Street intersection
- 6 barricades for 9<sup>th</sup> Street / Logan Street intersection
