

SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF CHERRY TREE ROAD FOR PLEASANT STREET CONSTRUCTION

DATE: FEBRUARY 13, 2024

As part of the ongoing Pleasant Street project, the city will be starting Phases 2 and 3 of construction in the near future. As part of this, Cherry Tree Road is impacted by Phase 3. This section of roadway will be at a significant elevation difference today as part of the bridge approach over Cicero Creek. It will be impacted from the earliest stages of that bridge construction. The closure for construction will begin approximately March 1, 2024 and last until completion of the project, late 2025.

In addition, because of the elevation difference, the northern leg of the intersection will not have direct access to the new Pleasant Street. The southern leg receives limited access (see attached exhibit) which allows for improved public safety access. Because of the curves and grade differences, a left turn from Cherry Tree onto Pleasant will not be allowed upon final completion.

Thus, this item is partially a request for closure during construction, as well as a permanent closure and cul-de-sac of the roadway north of future Pleasant. This item has been publicly discussed, however, direct mailer to affected residents on both sides of the future road has been sent, including the attached exhibit.

I recommend the Board of Public Works approve the closure of Cherry Tree Road for Pleasant Street construction.
