Dianna Lynch with the Hamilton County Administration contacted me on behalf of Hamilton County Councilman Brad Beaver. Mr. Beaver would like to include Riverside Cemetery in a Wreaths across America event in December. Wreaths across America is a volunteer effort to honor deceased veterans by placing evergreen wreaths on their graves. It is my understanding that volunteers place the wreaths on a specific day and then retrieve them at a later date. Because the veterans' graves at Riverside are already marked with flag holders, they should be easy to find. I have been assured that no City staff or resources will be needed for the project.
