CHECKLIST

- Property Information
 - Address
 - Acreage of property
 - Current zoning
- Project type (industrial, commercial, residential, mixed use, etc.)
- Project timeline (initial expectations)
- Conceptual site plan and renderings
- Project utility service needs
- Will you be seeking economic development assistance?
 - If so, what type of incentives are you interested in? (tax abatement, TIF funding, etc.)
 - If so, what are the expected project impacts? (total investment, number of FTE jobs, average anticipated wage, etc.)
