FEE SCHEDULE

A fee for re-inspections may be charged as indicated below:

First re-inspection:	No charge
Second re-inspection:	\$100.00
All subsequent re-inspections:	\$250.00

The fees assessed by this Fire Prevention Ordinance are in addition to those fines or fees that may be levied by the State of Indiana, Hamilton County, and/or the City of Noblesville. All payments are due within thirty (30) days from the date or the assessment of the fee. Violators who fail to make payment prior to the payment due date shall be assessed an additional Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) late fee for each outstanding fee and shall be subject to litigation for failure to pay an Ordinance violation fee.

VARIANCE/APPEALS PROCESS

To file for an appeal from any violation of the Fire Prevention Code of the City of Noblesville (any violation which begins with FPC 92...):

An owner or occupant requesting a variance from a specific provision of the Fire Prevention Code of the City of Noblesville or an appeal from a Notice of Violation or order that are not part of the state adopted fire and building laws as set forth by I.C. 22-13-2-11 shall apply in writing to the Fire Chief within five (5) working days of the date of the Notice of Violation or order. This variance or appeal shall be subject to an administrative fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

To file for an appeal from any other violations listed in this inspection report:

Please be advised that if you desire administrative review of this order, you must file a written petition for review with the:

You must identify the violations for which you seek review no later than 18 days from the date of this order. If you do so, your petition for review will be granted and an administrative proceeding will be conducted by an administrative law judge appointed by the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission. If you do not file a petition for review, this order will be final and you must comply with its requirements. Please be further advised that you may request an opportunity to informally discuss this decision prior to filing a petition for review. Such informal discussion or request, therefore, does not extend the deadline for filing a petition for review, and, therefore, any request for an informal discussion shall be made promptly, preferably by telephone (317-232-2222), upon receipt of this inspection report.
