AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO, AND THE OFFICIAL ZONE MAP, A PART OF THE
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE CITY OF NOBLESILLE, HAMILTON COUNTY, INDIANA
AND ITS JURISDICTIONAL LIMITS

An ordinance to amend the Unified Development Ordinance for the City of Noblesville, Hamilton County, Indiana, enacted by the City of Noblesville under authority of Chapter 174 of the Acts of the General Assembly 1947, as amended.

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission of the City of Noblesville has conducted a public hearing as required by law in regards to the change of zoning request and has sent its recommendation to the Common Council adopted on the $\frac{11}{1000}$ day of $\frac{11}{1000}$, 2002.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Noblesville, Hamilton County, Indiana, that the Unified Development Ordinance and the Official Zone Map for said City is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. That the subject real estate located at 8600 East 196th Street all of which is within the zoning jurisdiction of the City of Noblesville, Hamilton County, Indiana, is hereby rezoned from 'R1' Low Density Single Family Residential and 'OS' Open Space to 'R1/GUO' Low Density Single Family with a Government Use Overlay District, as designated in the Unified Development Ordinance for the City of Noblesville, and said real estate is more particularly described in attached Exhibit A.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and upon its adoption in accordance with the law.

Section 3. Upon motion duly made and seconded, this Ordinance was fully passed by the members of the Common Council this 90 day of 90, 2002.

This property is the site of the Noblesville Soccer Club. The City of Noblesville is seeking a change of zoning of this property to 'R1/GUO' Residential with a Government Use Overlay District. The property is owned by the City of Noblesville. The designation of 'OS' Open Space no longer exists as a part of the Unified Development Ordinance. The 'GUO' was established to be used in cases where the government use was expressly not permitted or the government use could not meet the development standards of the underlying district. This application for a change of zoning request is to designate the soccer fields a zoning classification in which the use is permitted. At this time, there

are no proposed changes such as additions to the soccer fields. Any modification of the existing plan would require a public hearing before the Commission for a preliminary planned development amendment.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff would recommend the Plan Commission **approve** this application and forward it onto the Council with a **favorable recommendation** to change the zoning from 'R1' Low Density Single Family Residential and 'OS' Open Space to 'R1/GUO' Residential with A Government Use Overlay District.

The Plan Commission's role dealing with the Change of Zoning Request is to recommend either approval or denial of the proposed ordinance to the City Council requesting the change of zoning. The Council, being the legislative body, has the **FINAL VOTE** as to whether they will accept the Plan Commission's recommendation and change the zoning as proposed.
