THE USE OF CHOKEHOLDS IS AGAINST NOBLESVILLE POLICE POLICY & IS NOT TAUGHT.




## REQUIRE DE-ESCALATION

NPD HAS POLICIES AND PROCEDURES TO DE-ESCALATE SITUATIONS WHEN OFFICERS ARRIVE ON THE SCENE.



## REQUIRE WARNING BEFORE SHOOTING

OFFICERS ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE WARNING IF IT DOES NOT PUT OTHER LIVES IN JEOPARDY.



## EXHAUST ALL OTHER MEANS

YES, BUT THE SIZE AND ABILITY OF AN OFFICER COULD CHANGE THE LEVEL OF FORCE NECESSARY.




## DUTY TO INTERVENE

OFFICERS ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE PROPER AND LAWFUL ACTION IF THEY OBSERVE WRONGFUL OR NEGLIGENT BEHAVIOR BY DEPARTMENT MEMBERS.



## BAN SHOOTING AT MOVING VEHICLES

SHOOTING AT MOVING VEHICLES IS BANNED, UNLESS THE OCCUPANTS ARE USING DEADLY FORCE TO KILL OTHERS.



## REQUIRE USE OF FORCE CONTINUUM

OFFICERS ARE REQUIRED TO USE THE MINIMUM AMOUNT OF OBJECTIVELY REASONABLE FORCE NECESSARY TO CONTROL THE SITUATION.



## REQUIRE COMPREHENSIVE REPORTING

NOBLESVILLE POLICE REQUIRES COMPREHENSIVE REPORTING BY OFFICERS WHEN THEY USE FORCE.

THE STATE OF INDIANA REQUIRES A MINIMUM OF 24 HOURS ANNUALLY OF OFFICER TRAINING. IN 2019, NPD AVERAGED 236 HOURS PER OFFICER.
