

# REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The City of Noblesville is requesting Proposals from select consulting firms who are qualified in providing professional services in conjunction with the following project:

# Safety Action Plan – Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A)

The Action Plan will be utilized to reduce roadway and pedestrian fatalities and serious injuries within the City of Noblesville's multi-modal transportation network. The Action Plan should create a thorough plan of various levels of involvement in order to ultimately achieve this goal. While the Action Plan should include the entirety of the Noblesville city limits, special attention and consideration should be given to the City of Noblesville's Central Business District. The Safety Action Plan must include all components laid out by the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) in the SS4A grant. ## The selected firm shall be responsible for the following:

- 1. Public and private stakeholder involvement
- 2. Collection of relevant data
- 3. Compilation of Safety Action Plan

#### A Consultant will be selected for this project based upon:

- 1. The firm's professional qualifications and experience in creating Safety Action Plans or similar planning efforts. INDOT Prequalification in the following categories:
  - a. Roadway Design and Plan Development
  - b. Public Involvement
  - c. Any additional INDOT prequalification to ensure complete project delivery
- 2. Experience and expertise of key personnel to be assigned to the project including the identified project manager.
- 3. The firm's approach for development of an action plan tailored to the needs of the City of Noblesville.
- 4. The ability to complete the work within the anticipated schedule. The selected Consultant shall have the capacity to complete this project and satisfy Owner



requirements on an accelerated timeline. The proposed completion date for the Action Plan is April 1, 2024.

The Proposal shall not exceed 10 pages in length. The Proposal will be evaluated on and should, at a minimum, include the following information:

- 1. Firm name, address, contact information, and authorized negotiator.
- 2. General firm information and qualifications, including location of the office performing the work.
- 3. Proposed staffing for the work, including designation of Project Manager and other key personnel.
- 4. Anticipated work to be subcontracted.
- 5. Statement of present workload on all other engineering projects.
- 6. A list or general description of relevant past projects completed on similar work types that would indicate your firm's ability to perform on this project.
- 7. A proposed schedule for project development from award of contract to completion of the Safety Action Plan.
- 8. Reasons why the City of Noblesville should select your firm. This should include strategic and creative project delivery.

### Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility, and Voluntary Exclusion

- The Consultant certifies, by submission of this proposal, that neither it nor its principals is presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from participating in covered transactions by any Federal department or agency.
- 2. Where the Consultant is unable to certify to any of the statements in this certification, such prospective participant shall attach an explanation to this proposal.

#### Title VI Assurance
